Duration: 3.5 Years

Welcome to your qualification and thank you for choosing North Kent College. Your Apprenticeship involves three parties – You, Your Employer and North Kent College. An Apprenticeship is a work-based training programme that combines on the job training with a nationally recognised qualification, and offers a direct route into the electro-technical installation profession.

The Apprenticeship framework you have chosen is 'Electro-Technical Installation' and this framework includes three sections as follows:

1. EAL Level 3 NVQ Diploma in Installing Electro-Technical Systems and Equipment
2. Functional Skills – English, Maths and ICT
3. **ERR – EMPLOYMENT RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

In order to achieve your full Apprenticeship framework you must complete all of the above sections. Some sections you may be exempt from but your Assessor will discuss this with you in more detail.

EAL Level 3 NVQ Diploma in Installing Electro-Technical Systems and Equipment

This qualification is for learners that are undertaking a summit skills apprenticeship framework, wish to become a competent electrician and would like to pursue a career in the Electro-technical/ building services sector. The qualification is made up of 17 mandatory units. Included in these units are 9 theory modules leading to on-screen exams, and 4 practical based Assignments. These units will enrich your understanding of Electro-technical practices, methods and procedures that are implemented in all aspects of industrial, commercial and domestic installation.

You will be required to attend college lessons, currently one day a week at our Gravesend campus. Your Employer must release you to attend these lessons as part of your Apprenticeship. All Assessments are set by EAL.

For your **FUNCTIONAL SKILLS**, you will be required to undertake Maths, English and ICT at the level relevant to your Apprenticeship framework. Exemptions are available if you have achieved a grade C or above at GCSE, or equivalent qualification, such as functional skills.

Your **ERR** section is to show you have received a full induction at your workplace and ensure that you understand your rights and responsibilities as an employee.

We hope you enjoy your time at North Kent College. The team will work with you to ensure that you achieve all sections of your Apprenticeship framework in order to gain your Apprenticeship Certificate.
