

# Hospitality Team Member Apprenticeship

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| <b>Qualification</b>               | Level 2 Hospitality Team Member  |
| <b>Based at</b>                    | Gravesend and workplace  |
| <b>Length of apprenticeship</b>    | Minimum of 12 months   |
| <b>Hours</b>                       | Day release of 6 hours per week (4 hours in a practical context and 2 hours classroom based)   |
| <b>Entry requirements</b>          | Achieved or working towards Level 1 in English and maths GCSE grade 3 (D)  |
| <b>Description</b>                 | <p>The programme is achieved mainly through practical training that you receive in your workplace and supplemented by practical and theory sessions delivered in College. This takes place in our training restaurant, production kitchen and classrooms. There will be classroom and kitchen/restaurant led activities and tasks that will enable you to develop your knowledge and understanding of the principles, techniques and theory associated with hospitality</p> <p>The programme allows you to specialise in areas such as food and beverage service, alcoholic beverage service, Barista service or food production</p>   |
| <b>Assessment methods</b>          | <p>The practical aspects of the qualification will be assessed in your workplace and during sessions at College and evidenced in your portfolio showing that you have met the competencies and standards required. Your knowledge will be assessed through workbooks and tests. English and maths will be undertaken at College and assessed by online tests</p> <p>You will then be summatively assessed to the apprenticeship standard using four complementary assessment methods by an independent end assessor. The assessment is synoptic, i.e. takes a view of the overall performance of the apprentice in their job. These include: On demand test, observation, business project and professional discussion</p> |
| <b>Maths &amp; English content</b> | Functional Skills or GCSE English and maths will be studied depending on your existing grades. There will be no further English and maths study for those with grade 4 (C) or above  |
| <b>Progression options</b>         | Progression from this apprenticeship is expected to be into a hospitality supervisory or team leading role or hospitality supervisor apprenticeship  |
