Entry requirements	GCSE grades 4 (C) including English and maths
Description	Subjects include: mandatory units: communication and professional relationships with children, young people and adults; engage in personal development in health; social care of children's and young people's settings; promote children and young people's positive behaviour; promote equality, diversity and inclusion in work with children and young people; schools as organisations; support assessment for learning; support learning activities; understand child and young person development. Plus a selection of optional units
Assessment methods	Assessment in the workplace of knowledge, competency and work skills will be via observations, professional discussions and setting work based projects
Maths & English content	Functional Skills or GCSE English, maths and ICT with exemptions for GCSE grades 4 (C) or above
Progression options	Progression into a variety of job roles including Teaching Assistant, Classroom and Learning Support Assistants
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
