

# Motor Vehicle Maintenance & Repair Level 2 Apprenticeship

<b>Qualification</b>	Autocare Technician Level 2 Apprenticeship Standard
<b>Based at</b>	Gravesend
<b>Length of apprenticeship</b>	23 months generally may take up to 30 months
<b>Hours</b>	Working 5 days a week for a motor vehicle business, with one of those days being attendance at college during term time; with further time at college or in training to fulfil the 20% off the job training requirement
<b>Entry requirements</b>	GCSE Maths and English Grade 2 (E) or above, although those with lower grades may be considered
<b>Description</b>	The gaining of knowledge and practical skills to complement those learnt within the working environment for working on light vehicles, up to the Autocare Technician Level 2 Apprenticeship Standard
<b>Assessment methods</b>	Once the apprentice is deemed competent by their employer they will be put forward for an End Point Assessment which comprises of examinations, practical skills testing and a professional discussion
<b>Maths &amp; English content</b>	Functional skills in Maths and English to allow apprentices to gain Functional Skills Level 1 qualifications and to work towards Functional Skills Level 2 qualifications; exemptions will be given if the apprentice already holds equivalent qualifications
<b>Progression options</b>	There are progression routes to Level 3
