Dartford Campus

Our Dartford Campus is located slightly out of the town centre on Oakfield Lane and the campus has several green open space areas for students to enjoy.

Our Dartford Campus offers students and staff a FREE Shuttle Bus service from Dartford station running regularly in term times.

The campus boasts the highly acclaimed Miskin Theatre and our brand new industry leading stateof-the-art Miskin Creative and Performance Studios (opened in September 2022). We also host our own radio station and shows on-site from our very own Miskin studios.

We also offer excellent sports and fitness facilities located at the "Osterberg Centre." So called Osterberg because part of the Oakfield Lane Campus was purchased in 1895 by Martina Bergman-Österberg, who created a physical training college specialising in gymnastics for girls and young women. She is also credited for the introduction of the use of gymslips for women playing sports, and played a key role in the early development of netball. Physical education continued on the site until 1986.

We have a Learning Technology Centre which is a fabulous resource for both study and leisure. We also have a Student Zone for our students as a place to relax and have fun with their friends between lessons. We offer our smaller cafeteria called The Atrium Cafe and our main restaurant and snack bar area, called The Food Court, which can accommodate over 200 students. Both offer great deals on breakfast, lunch and snacks.



Gravesend Campus

Our Gravesend Campus is located slightly outside of the town centre and hosts a blend of courses for vocational trades and specialist careers which give it a distinct workplace-like quality.

The campus also boasts The National Maritime Training Centre which is a leading provider of maritime education and practical training, providing up to date equipment and expert training using dedicated specialist classrooms, a Fire Training Ground and Thameside Jetty.

In the Construction and Engineering workshops there are types of equipment and workplace practices that mirror the best employers in the industry along with workshops for Engineering, Plumbing, Brickwork and many more trades.

Tonbridge Campus

Qualifications Explained

Entry Level Certificates

These qualifications are available to those who may not have the GCSE grades to go straight on to a Level 1 mainstream course, acting as a step-up qualification.

UAL, NCFE & BTEC Diplomas

These are one or two year full-time courses specialising in a specific vocational area at Levels 1 to 4. They are made to accommodate the needs of employers and allow for progression to university, providing practical real-life learning with a key theoretical background. BTECs and NCFEs Level 3 can be taken instead of A Levels as a route to university.

VRQ (Vocationally Related Qualifications)

These courses, much like BTECs, specialise in specific vocational areas from Level 1 to 3. They aim to prepare you for the world of work focusing on a practical hands-on approach to learning, with theory to support this. These qualifications aim to help you find employment or progress within your career.

City and Guilds

These are job-based qualifications that are specifically designed to improve the work skills of employees and are suitable if the career you want requires a practical based training programme, or is ideal if you're already in a job and need to further your skills.

T Levels

T Levels are advanced Level 3 courses and equivalent to 3 A-levels. They offer longer periods of Industry Placement (usually up to 3 months). The course is a combination of in-class study and work placement.

Access to Higher Education

These courses are for people over the age of 19 who are interested in taking on an undergraduate degree programme, who do not already have the required qualifications.

Apprenticeships

With an apprenticeship you will be employed with an organisation and will do your technical training at the College. This means you will get paid and achieve a qualification at the same time. An apprenticeship can take between one and four years to complete and covers over 1500 job roles in a wide range of industries.

Foundation Degrees and HNC/Ds

Foundation Degrees and Higher National Certificates and Diplomas are undergraduate qualifications that are equivalent to years 1 and 2 of a university Bachelor's Degree. These programmes offer a more vocational element to university degrees, often with links to the industry itself.

Professional Qualifications

These provide practical and work-related skills and the opportunity to gain nationally recognised qualifications, including AAT (Association of Accounting Technicians) and CACHE (Council for Awards in Care, Health and Education).


GCSE English & maths

It is a Government requirement that all 16-18 year old students who have not yet passed GCSE English and maths with at least Grade 4 or C, to continue to study English and maths from the age of 16. Students who come to us with a Grade 3 or D at GCSE will receive support throughout the year to be able to re-take their GCSE in the Summer term. Students with a Grade 2 or E or below will be enrolled on Functional Skills programmes in English and maths which act as a stepping stone towards taking the GCSE in future years.

Work Placements

The industry placement scheme particularly, is designed to give students on Level 2 & 3 courses, approximately 50 days of relevant and substantive industry placements.

What are T Levels?

T Levels are new courses for 16-18 year olds which follow GCSEs and are equivalent to 3 A levels. These 2-year courses, have been developed working with employers so that the content meets the needs of industry and prepares students for skilled employment, higher study or apprenticeships.

T Levels offer students a mixture of classroom learning and 'on-the-job' experience during an industry placement of at least 315 hours (approximately 45 days). Students get valuable experience in the workplace and employers get early sight of the new talent in their industry.

T Levels include:

- Technical knowledge and practical skills specific to the student's chosen industry or occupation
- An industry placement of at least 45 days in their chosen industry or occupation
- Relevant English and maths skills
- Common workplace skills

Students who achieve a T Level will get a nationally recognised certificate which employers will use as evidence in their recruitment. T Levels will offer students a mixture of classroom or workshop-based learning and 'on-the-job' experience.

What can I study?

T Levels have been introduced gradually around the country, and North Kent College offers: **Construction**, **Engineering and manufacturing**, **Legal**, **Childcare**, **Healthcare and Land/Animal Management** T Level qualifications.

Options after your GCSEs


There are many options after your GCSEs, from vocational programmes, to A Levels, to apprenticeships and they can all lead to your chosen career, but what are the best routes for you? Here's an idea of the paths you can take.

Levels of study

Depending on GCSE results (or predicted results), our tutors will recommend what level of study to apply for. This will be discussed at interview, but can be moved at enrolment after GCSE results.

As you can see, after GCSEs, students can start at Entry Level or Level 1 or 2 which are completed in 1 year and move to Level 3 which is equivalent of A Levels, or you can go straight into a Level 3 programme and move onto Level 4, university or into employment once completed.

For students wishing to go to university or study Higher Education programmes, a Level 3 Extended Diploma is required by universities in the subject (or closely related subject) to the one you wish to study. We have a number of courses that can lead to university.



Work Placements

Our vision is for our students to be the first choice for employers.

A work placement is one of the best ways for you to achieve being career-ready at the end of your course. Our students can work with employers around their college timetable (*only applicable to certain courses) to gain consistent, long-term experience and exposure in their desired industry.

Placements are available to students aged 16-18 (or SEN students up to the age of 24) on Level 2 or 3 courses, and a selection process is in place to find placements that best fit both students and employers.

If you want to complete a work placement, you'll get the chance to work with some successful local Small, Medium Enterprises (SMEs), prestigious organisations in and around London or innovative start-ups, all relevant to the qualification you're studying.

You'll be expected to complete a placement of approximately 50 days over the year, either 1 or 2 days a week whilst you are not timetabled to be at college. The placement forms the perfect complement to the education programme because they are with employers that are highly relevant to your studies and appropriate to your end qualification. You'll also receive careers advice, help with writing CVs and application forms and developing interview techniques. You'll attend three Pre-Employment Training (PET) sessions with experts from the Bluewater Learning Shop to make sure you know what to expect in the workplace and what will be expected of you.

The benefits of a Work Placement:

- You will be working in the industry of your choice, giving you a better chance of employment after you graduate.
- You will be able to apply the learning from your classroom, into a real business environment.
- You will be working with and learning from employees within your chosen industry.
- You will be working for a company who may be looking to recruit in the future and who will remember you.
- You can find your own placement in a company you want to work for – this means you get to make a great first impression with a potential employer.
- Having a placement on your CV shows you are committed to the industry and willing to work hard – this puts you ahead of other applicants when it comes to applying for jobs.

You can use your part-time job as a placement if it is in a relevant industry.

An industry placement will enhance your UCAS application if you are progressing to University.

Apprenticeships at NKC

Why not start to build your career with an apprenticeship?

Did you know North Kent College is one of the country's leading apprenticeship providers (Hadlow College is one of the country's leading Land-based Colleges)

No matter what stage you are within your career, whether just starting out in the world of work or already an established member of staff, Apprenticeships can support you to develop your skills, knowledge and behaviours in your chosen profession via an apprenticeship scheme, and is perfect solution to earn while you learn.

What is an apprenticeship?

An apprenticeship is a real job that gives you a learning platform to train and develop your skills, knowledge and behaviours in your chosen profession.

20% of your contracted working hours will be spent in training and development, either with us at college, or even in your workplace. The remainder of your time will be spent applying and developing your skills and knowledge deeper in your workplace.





Apprenticeship FAQs

Do Apprentices get paid?

As an apprentice, you'll usually be employed to work a minimum of 30 hours per week and be paid a wage no less than the National Minimum Apprenticeship Rate – £5.28 per hour, for the time you are in work and in off-the-job training.

You can also undertake an apprenticeship if you are a part time employee, in these circumstances we will review your part-time working hours and extend the duration of your apprenticeship to ensure you receive the required level of training needed.

The amount you are paid is based on several factors including your previous experience and current skill set. Within some job roles your wage may increase as you progress and take on more responsibility. You will also receive the same benefits as any employee, including holiday pay.

Who can do an Apprenticeship?

Apprenticeships are open to anyone who is 16 years old and over, has a right to work in England and is not in full time education. There is no upper age limit and available to anyone whether starting out on their career or for those who have been working for some time.

Levels of Apprenticeships

Apprenticeships can now support your learning ambitions to the highest level, however it is important to know that Apprenticeship levels are based on the job role and duties and responsibilities that sit within the Job Role. English and maths are a fundamental part to successfully achieve your Apprenticeship, they are essential to support your longer-term career prospects and progression. As an apprentice you will be required to achieve a Maths and English qualification (if you don't already have one) as part of your apprenticeship. What is the End Point Assessment?

Once your apprenticeship's practical training period is completed, you will be entered through the Apprenticeship Gateway. Once you have been accepted and approved through the Gateway, The End Point Assessment Organisation (EPAO) will appoint an independent assessor, who will undertake a series of competency tests on you, this could include, an exam, a practical observation of skills learnt, professional discussion, review of your portfolio of evidence and or project.

The End Point Assessment is your opportunity to demonstrate that you are genuinely competent in your occupation by allowing you to showcase what you have learnt throughout your apprenticeship. Each apprenticeship programme has a slightly different assessment approach however what they all have in common is that they'll assess the knowledge, skills and behaviours you have developed during your apprenticeship. 



Land & Wildlife Management

Hadlow Campus

This course has a mixture of practical and theory lessons and is delivered to make use of the excellent resources we have on site and the range of experience within the faculty team. This qualification covers the skills and knowledge required for you to enter employment in the countryside sector specialising in land and wildlife management industries.

This qualification gives you the opportunity to study a range of specialist technical practical skills and gain knowledge that builds upon the skills required for working in the countryside management sector such as estate maintenance skills, population surveys, safe use of equipment and machinery with further areas of study such as land use and recreation. It will enable you to develop specialist skills such as woodland and coastal habitat management, river fishery management and habitat management learning on our large estate.

This is a one-year, full time qualification. Practical and theory lessons will take place throughout your study programme and we work with local employers who will contribute to the delivery of your qualification by providing talks and offering work experience. In addition, trips will occur to support your learning experience. The course is assessed via internally set assignments and externally set exams.



You can progress onto a Level 3 Advanced Technical Diploma Land and Wildlife Management (Year 2) Countryside or Fisheries stream. HE to study towards careers in fisheries management, conservation and biodiversity.

SEN Support

The Learning Support & Inclusion team provides support to students who have an EH&CP (Education, Health & Care Plan). There may also be additional support for students with disabilities and for those students with specific learning difficulties, including dyslexia, if supporting evidence is provided.

Student Financial Support

Money and finance doesn't have to be a worrying experience. We want your transition into College to be as smooth as possible. Therefore, we have plenty of information available to help you to understand what costs are involved and how you can find out if you are eligible for any financial support. Don't forget that there are no tuition fees for full-time Further Education courses if you're aged 16-18 years.

Students who are on a full-time course (funded either by the government or via a 19+ Advanced Learner Loan) may be entitled to financial assistance from the College's discretionary bursary which can help with course-related costs and travel to and from College. Bursaries are individually tailored depending on the course the student is studying, where they live and how they travel to College.

The bursary is only a contribution towards course-related costs and travel, so will not necessarily cover the full amount. These costs could include, but are not limited to the following:

- Course contribution/course materials fee applicable to your course
- Essential books, kit, uniform or equipment required for your course
- Free College meals subject to meeting the criteria set by the Government
- Travel allowance (depending on where you live and the number of days you attend College). Please see website for further information.
- Childcare costs for 1 child only for students aged 20 or above. Students under the age of 20 should apply to the National Care to Learn Scheme for assistance with childcare

Getting to College



It's really easy to get to North Kent College and we are always striving to find the best deals for our students, whether you live locally to Dartford, Gravesend or Tonbridge.

Dartford students – Catch a FREE shuttle bus from Dartford Station to the Dartford Campus and back. (Timetable will start in September. The shuttle bus service does not run during the holidays or enrolment.)

For students travelling from a London Borough, you can apply for the 16+ Oyster or 18+ Oyster Card through the Transport for London website. This will give free/ discounted travel on buses within London up to and including Dartford (Zone 8).

For students travelling from Kent (you must live in Kent) you can apply for the KCC 16+ Travel Saver Card through the Kent County Council Website.

For students aged 16-17 who travel by train outside of London, you can apply through National Rail for a 16-17 Travel Card, which reduces the cost of a ticket by **50%** for 16 & 17 year olds.

Students aged 18+ who require to travel by train outside of London can apply for the 16-25 Railcard which gives a 1/3 off rail fares.

Students travelling from East Sussex can apply for the 3i-d card in order to pay reduced fares for bus travel. A unique Organisation code (UOC) is required to apply for this card. The UOC for the Hadlow region is HAD231 and for the West Kent (Tonbridge) region it is WES93A. To apply please visit the 3i-D CitizenCard website.

How does College work?

College is different to school in both the approach and type of education taught. Schools tend to focus on A Level pathways while College focuses on vocational, hands-on learning to give young people the skills they need to gain employment or go on to university.

Not only are courses delivered in exceptionally high commercial-standard learning environments, from workshops, to salons, kitchens and theatres, but they are taught by industry-experienced tutors with a focus on giving students the expertise that employers need – we're dedicated to helping our students gain employment or progress into higher education on completion of their courses.

For students wanting to start work at 18 we strongly recommend a vocational programme to learn the skills employers want rather than the academic A Level route.

College courses generally run over 3 or 4 days per week which allows students to undertake work placements or work experience, giving them additional employment skills and to earn money. We work closely with employers to offer industry placements alongside your course.

Remember, young people must stay in education or training until 18 years of age, but that doesn't mean they must stay at school – there are alternatives: studying at College, or on-the-job training through an apprenticeship.

How to apply

Apply for a course

Once you have decided on one or more courses that you're interested in, you can apply via our website, using our online application form.

Choosing the right course

If you're not sure what you want to study, you can browse our website, which has a comprehensive guide to the courses we offer. You can also book an appointment to see one of our careers advisers who are based at all of our campuses.

When to apply

Applications open late in September and we would advise you to apply as soon as possible as some course places are limited and we don't want you to miss out. Late applications will be considered, however spaces cannot be guaranteed.

What happens next?

Your application will be processed and we'll ask you to come in for an interview; this will be to make sure that you're applying for the right course. You may need to take an entry test, but don't worry it's only to determine what level you're at. You may need to bring examples of work, but you'll be told this prior to your interview. Once accepted, we'll send you a letter to confirm your place.

Enrolment

You will be invited in to enrol at the end of August. You will be advised when to come in and what to bring with you. Once you've enrolled, you will officially be a student with us!
