



FdA Early Years Additional Costs

This document highlights the costs that students may have to meet in addition to their course fees and normal travel costs to attend lessons:

Work-Based Learning:

All students are required to work within an appropriate early years setting on an employed or in some cases voluntary role and any expenses required for travel or otherwise are students' responsibility

Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) Check:

Student DBS checks are not required by the college however, it is a legal requirement for those working in early years settings. Although some organisations will process this at no cost to the student, others will require the student to pay for this themselves.

If students wish to, they may pay for a DBS check through North West Kent College at a cost of £44.00.

Trips:

Students will require travel expenses to and from University of Greenwich Avery Hill Campus is expected for Induction and one or two days of seminars and training through-out the year. University 'Open' and/or 'Progression' days are where students are provided with information relating to progression into year 3 of their chosen Top-Up Year programme. Students may also wish to attend other trips, events and seminars The travel arrangements and expenses for these events are the responsibility of the student.

Coursework:

A USB stick is required for capturing assessment work for moderation by the External Examiner at the end of the academic year. Other resources used in the production of the coursework and any

stationery including extra printing costs and any books or magazine subscriptions are the responsibility of the student.
